his beautiful property is located in the highlands area of Vista Mar, a short distance from the lovely town of Orotina. Orotina is situated in the Alajuela province - one of the central provinces of Costa Rica.

Vista Mar is approximately 2200' (700m) above sea level and this means that the daily temperature range is between 20C - 30C all year round. Additionally, the area's low humidity levels results in you being comfortable and your electricity bills being low.

The driving time between Vista Mar and Orotina is less than 15 minutes on safe, quiet, paved roads.

In addition to being conveniently located near Orotina, the property is perfectly situated for making the most of the some of Costa Rica's most stunning beaches and to the San Jose international airport. Here are some examples of the driving times to these locations:

International Airport - 45 mins
Punta Arenas - 45 mins
Playa Dona Ana - 30 mins
Carara National Park - 30 mins
Lake Arenal - 2 hr 45 mins

You can find Orotina located in the north Pacific region of Costa Rica, just at the foot of the Monte del Aguacate. This town is found about halfway between the other communities of Quepos and Atenas, west of Alajuela.

You can reach Orotina by road; it is only an hour's drive west from the capital city of <u>San José</u>. This picturesque agricultural community is known for its amazing wealth of produce; the amazing variety of fresh Costa Rica fruits and vegetables is made possible by the excellent year-round weather. In fact, Orotina is often referred to simply as "the fruit town," a nickname it has richly earned thanks to its noteworthy agricultural output.

Orotina has a population of just over 20000 and residents have access to a range of modern conveniences. Some of the services to be found in Orotina include:

Whilst everything you need on a daily basis is available in Orotina, the outskirts of Costa Rica's capital, San Jose, are only 45 minutes away should you feel like a day out in some busier surroundings.
